SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I've explained what my amendment does. If anybody wants to question me, I will answer those questions. But to say it again in a nutshell, when we use the word "recidivism," we do not have to add the redundant words "of criminal behavior." The construction...it is not even good syntax. You might say, recidivism in the person or by the person, but not recidivism of criminal behavior. Then I would strike the words "within the court system" in line 14, because they are redundant. All of this will occur within the court system. So I hope you would adopt my amendment to Senator Beutler's amendment. But I want to look at another part of the bill, on page 2. Senator Aguilar, I'm not going to ask you a question, but I'm going to tell you where I'm going, so you can follow it. In line 6 on page 2, once again at the end of the...toward the end of the line, after the word "recidivism," I would strike "of criminal behavior." Then on line 9 I have to ask you a question. Since this is a drug court, we're talking only about drug offenses, aren't we?

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Aguilar, would you yield?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Aren't we?

SENATOR AGUILAR: Yes, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So I would strike the word "certain" and insert the word "drug" on line 9. And then on that same line, after the word "alternative," they say "component of the." I would strike "component of the," and put the word "to." Then instead of saying this is an alternative component of the traditional criminal justice or juvenile justice system, it would say, this is an alternative to the traditional. So I would strike "component of" and insert the word "to." Then it would say an alternative to the traditional criminal justice system. And these are amendments that I would have offered to you before we even got on the floor, had we not gotten on the floor. But that's not up there right now. I will offer it later. And it will give me a time to continue talking about
