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to be put after "recidivism," but we would, in lines 16 and 17, strike the words "of criminal behavior," so that we say, it has been successful, or whatever that terminol...that language is, in reducing recidivism. We don't have to say recidivism of criminal behavior. There is recidivistic conduct. There is recidivism as a noun. But there is no recidivism of criminal behavior. It would be like saying, a crime of criminal behavior. So we don't need the words "of criminal behavior." And nobody spoke against those two amendments, so I'm asking that they be amended into Senator Beutler's amendment. His would remain before us, with the addition of what I'm offering. Now, back to this bill. If the goal is to bring uniformity, and if the drug court program is going to be administered pursuant to rules and regulations promulgated and adopted by the Nebraska Supreme Court, that's all it should say. You should strike everything else from this bill, put that language into it, and see what happens as a result. If that turns out not to be acceptable, we can come back in. But then we will have something in the way of guidance, direction, and input from all of the counties that have drug courts now. An amendment of the kind that I mentioned...not this one we're talking about here; I hope you'll adopt it. An amendment of the kind that I was mentioning does not say that drug courts are hereby abolished, and if any are to be created. It doesn't do that. It starts where things are right now, and then will have the amendatory language, which may or may not be offered. But since we're not at that point yet, I'm asking you to adopt my amendment. Then we can discuss Senator Beutler's a bit more, where he specifies district court as the court which should administer all drug court programs. Because his amendment, remember, would become a part of statute which governs everything in the state. And if that's adopted, it automatically is going to nullify at least one drug court program's operation. Thank you, Mr. President. I'm asking that you adopt my amendment to Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the closing on FA1306 to FA1304, which is an amendment to LB 454. The question before the body is, shall FA1306 be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of the Chambers amendment to the Beutler amendment to
