SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...are things like childcare and other expenses a person would have which, while attending this program, might not be able to be met if payments have to be made to the program. So it shouldn't just be where you have no means at all. And that is not an issue that had been raised before. But I'm just mentioning another thing which if we got to this part of the bill where we're talking about the nondiscrimination, there are things that I would want to see done there too. But right now, we're discussing aspects of the bill in order to give time for Senator Hartnett's amendment to be drafted and brought down here. But in order that we don't have to engage in what would be called make work if we were on the job, I'm going go ahead and offer another amendment to Senator Beutler's, which is along the line of what we've been talking about, where we kind of smooth out language without necessarily changing the meaning of everything. And if Senator Hartnett's amendment is adopted, all of this will go away.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Beutler. And I'm sorry, this is your...you have spoken three times. I'm sorry. You have your closing left, but there are other senators wishing to speak. Senator Pederson. Don, that is.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I know we're all concerned with finances. Certainly, our Appropriations Committee, as you know, has been working overtime trying to match the needs of the state with the resources of the state. And I know, Senator Aguilar, you mentioned that this program is currently funded by the federal government, and that we don't have any expenses. But I don't see anything in this bill that refers to any finances being furnished by the federal government. And what I'm concerned with, it's been our
