SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Pedersen. Senator Erdman. Senator Erdman? He waives the opportunity to speak. Senator Hartnett, there are no further lights on. You're recognized to close on your amendment, FA1308, to LB 454.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President, members of the body, what my amendment does is simply leave the language in that there will be drug courts, and there will be rules and regs promulgated by the Supreme Court. And I ask for the adoption of this amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. You've heard the closing on FA1308. The question before the body is, shall FA1308 be adopted to LB 454? All in favor of the question vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of FA1308, offered by Senator Hartnett to LB 454. Have you all voted who wish to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Hartnett's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President. Senator Foley, I have your amendment, Senator.

SENATOR FOLEY: Withdraw that, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Back to discussion of advancement of LB 454 to E & R Initial. Open for discussion. Senator Chambers.
