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SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President, members of the body, what we've done with the division, everything which we have previously been discussing is appropriate for discussion as...Mr. President, point of inquiry.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Yes.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Are we on the amendment to the amendment? I guess I'm confused,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: ...and I'm admitting that on the record, whether we're debating the amendment to the amendment. The division applied to the committee amendment, did it not?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: It did, Senator. We probably are premature in ordering the division, but if...we can take your amendment to the committee amendment to the second component, if you want to proceed that way. Are you okay with that? (AM1355, Legislative Journal page 1298.)

SENATOR BRASHEAR: That would be fine.

CLERK: Okay.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: And I'm sorry for my confusion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Is that agreeable with you, Senator Brashear?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, it is.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may continue.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: This amendment to the second division...to the first division of the committee amendment, Sections 2 through the end, is simply designed to make certain that we do not have to debate issues, put it on the record, such as
