SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR BROWN: And so it's the board that has oversight over that field.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Here's the bottom line question I want to get to. Is it possible that two different boards may have had oversight over an individual within the last five years?

SENATOR BROWN: Probably not, because if...it would be the board of physicians versus the Board of Nursing, the medical board versus the Board of Nursing, and all those within the nursing profession would be under the Board of Nursing.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. What about as between states, for example? Might a doctor have been under the examining board in Iowa for a period of three years and then Nebraska for two years? I don't know quite how that works, but what I'm trying to get at, is this going to cover the previous five years regardless of the fact that they may have been under one examining board or more than one examining board?

SENATOR BROWN: I believe it does, but that's something that I will check on to make sure.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR BROWN: But it was certainly our intention that it...that that be the case. And so if there's better language, but I will, you know, I'll work with you on that, but I don't...I think that it's accomplished by the language.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah. Well, I'm not sure the language is inadequate, but I just wanted to understand the structure better as to how that would work. Thank you. Thank you, Senator Cudaback.
