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SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. Senator Stuhr, I understand your amendment to the committee amendments. But could I jump over that and ask Senator Raikes just a few questions, if he would answer them?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, would you respond to a question from Senator Janssen?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Raikes, I was a little late getting up here. And I didn't get in on the opening. But I'm looking at some letters that I had received from some of my districts. And I tried to catch what you were saying. Now, one of the areas that we're addressing is the option enrollment date. Is that correct?

SENATOR RAIKES: Right. Yes.

SENATOR JANSSEN: That date is moved from the 31st of March to in July sometime?

SENATOR RAIKES: Actually, it's from the 15...well,...

SENATOR JANSSEN: The 15th?

SENATOR RAIKES: The green copy moved it from the...well, 15th of March to the 1st of July. But in effect, the only relevant date, as it would stand with the committee amendment, is July 1. Is that, options that occur after July 1 would be treated differently, in the sense that there would be a ban on participation in athletics for 90 days if the option took place after July 1.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right. And I understand that there has been some problems with activities. But the whole optioning part of it has been moved then a little bit later in the year. That's the only change that is make?

SENATOR RAIKES: Well, actually, the March 15 date which is
