So I'd like to ask her to maybe answer on the mike. We can have a little dialog back and forth. And first of all, Senator Stuhr, thank you for bringing the bill. I think it's something that we needed to do. And as you know, I signed on to your bill, and I'm supportive. But I'm going to follow up with the questions that Senator Price asked, and..regarding those transfer students. And I was caught by the lobbyist for Lincoln schools out in the Rotunda, and he's concerned because transfer students, which are students that move from one high school to another high school within the same district, are not addressed in this particular bill. And your response to Senator Price was that, no, they're not addressed in statute now, and you didn't include them under this bill. Who then governs what happens to those transfer students?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuhr.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: In regard to this issue. Who. .I mean, it...I'm trying to put words in your mouth, Senator Stuhr. It's the NCAA (sic), right?
