SENATOR CUDABACK:      Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator, did you understand the request for division? Why don't you come forward for a minute, Senator Stuhr. Come up. Come forward, Senator Stuhr. Thank you, Senator Stuhr, for coming up. It is divisible. Mr. Clerk, read the division.

ASSISTANT CLERK:      Mr. President, the first division we will consider is the first section, which is the emergency clause. (FA1318, Legislative Journal page 1301.)

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Senator Stuhr, you're recognized to open on the first divided question.

SENATOR STUHR:      Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I would hope that we might just act very quickly and adopt the emergency clause to the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Thank you. You heard the opening on the first component of the divided question. There are several lights on. I could read those lights. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER:      Senator Cudaback, since my questions are basically background questions on the bill itself and all aspects of the bill, I suppose I might as well speak now as later. And I think I would like to direct my questions to Senator Raikes, if I could, if Senator Raikes would be available to respond.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Senator Raikes, would you respond to a question from Senator Beutler?

SENATOR RAIKES:      Yes.
