SENATOR STUHR: I'm not sure. I will find out.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Then I will let you check that out.

SENATOR STUHR: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And then I will proceed.

SENATOR STUHR: All right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: How much time do I have, Mr. President?

SENATOR CUDABACK: About two minutes, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. I'm not certain that the emergency clause needs to be added to this bill. I'm not certain that it needs to take effect immediately. I'm not even sure that the bill needs to be passed. We...let me ask Senator Stuhr one more question. Senator Stuhr, the question is this. This bill deals only with those fees in extracurricular activities. Isn't that true?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuhr.

SENATOR STUHR: No, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Let me know what else it deals with.

SENATOR STUHR: Okay. Actually, it deals with the enrollment option program. Yes, it keeps the dates in place of March 15, which we originally had. What I want to emphasize is, it is...it's been a problem that students have been optioning for extracurricular purposes. What this bill attempts to do is to take away that emphasis off of the extracurricular activities and put it back on the education option enrollment as it was originally implemented for...
