SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. We're discussing FA1319, which is the second component of the divided Stuhr amendment to the committee amendments. On with discussion, Senator Raikes, did you wish to use your...your light was on. Thank you. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, Mr. President, before I start asking Senator Raikes some questions, I'd like to ask Senator Stuhr a question, if she is nearby.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuhr, are you available for a question? Senator Stuhr, are you available for a question?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'd like to ask Senator Stuhr a question. Senator Stuhr, you have mentioned the number of schools that have been in favor of this. How many did you say favor this bill?

SENATOR STUHR: There were different votes. One vote was 226 to 33.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR STUHR: And then, I mean there were several. They've been working on it since 2000-2001 school year.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I presume the reason you're telling us that is that it's a majority should rule kind of issue.

SENATOR STUHR: Well, I...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is that what that is for?

SENATOR STUHR: Well, I think it shows the concern and the support that the issue has to the member schools.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And it must be your feeling that if that is what the majority wants, then that's what the majority should get. Is that what you're...is that the argument, or is that not the argument?
