What will that maximum dollar amount be that is listed?

SENATOR RAIKES: Senator, my...

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay, so it's a category two item. The maximum fee that could be charged for the category two item is "X" dollars. So I don't know that that would necessarily reflect only price changes that could be causing that to vary.
