they might incur if they don't make a timely disclosure to the commission, and we discovered there was only a \$25 fine. That's a rather paltry fine and we need to fix that. That's what this amendment is all about. It changes it to a \$100 fine, subject to a limit of \$1,000, and that would make it consistent with some of the fines that you and I might incur if we make a late filing on some of our disclosures. So I'd ask for the advance of this particular amendment, AM1408. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Foley. Open for discussion on the Foley amendment. Seeing none, Senator Foley, you're recognized to close, and he waives closing. The question then is the adoption of AM1408 to LB 349. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Foley's amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Foley. Senator Mossey, you're recognized for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 349 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is to advance LB 349. All in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. It does advance. LB 498.

CLERK: LB 498, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 498 to E & R for engrossing.
