CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 476 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is to advance LB 476 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The bill does advance. LB 97.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 97. Senator Mossey, I do have Enrollment and Review amendments first of all. (AM7108, Legislative Journal page 1302.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 97.
