SENATOR CHAMBERS: So it will not go very far, so it shouldn't cost very much.

SENATOR HARTNETT: That's right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. I will support your bill.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Hartnett, your light is next on the amendment.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I simply rise to agree with what Senator Beutler has said. I think he pointed out a flaw, a little flaw, in the bill as it was originally introduced, so I'd ask for the adoption of this Beutler amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Members of the Legislature, yes, I will support Senator Beutler's amendment, but in the hearing this was very evident that they would not close that alley unless there was access to the street, and I took them for their word on that. But this just reaffirms that they will have to abide by the no access into the alley. Thank you.
