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guilty unless he or she can prove innocence. That's not so. You would be arrested for carrying a concealed weapon under the same circumstances that you would be arrested for being suspected of busting somebody upside the head with a club. The arrest does not establish guilt. The filing of charges does not establish guilt. Senator Tyson didn't know that, and they've listened to this discredited, dishonest person named John Lott so long that they incorporate his misinformation and state it time and time again on this floor. The existing law does provide circumstances allowing a person, without punishment, to carry a concealed weapon right now, but you cannot carry it for a frivolous, nonsensical reason or for no reason, other than that you want to pack heat. This bill is preposterous, and if as much irresponsibility were shown by my colleagues who support it in every other area that is being shown here, then we justifiably would be laughed out of office and run out of office.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I think a person who's going to carry one of these guns concealed ought to have to have insurance. You have to have insurance to drive a vehicle. Why? They say it's a dangerous instrumentality. And you could say, well, why do I have to carry insurance? Cars don't kill people; people kill people. But you have to have insurance because it's a dangerous instrumentality. You're out there making use of it around other people who may be harmed by your use of that instrumentality. And a pistol is the same thing, only worse. A pistol is designed to kill. And if it were not designed to kill, the projectile would not be lethal. So when these gun nuts want to say, well, pistols aren't designed to kill anybody, it shows how preposterous their position is and they know it so they have to misstate. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Schimek.
