have said, we've been carrying guns for years and we'd like to do it legally. A small party says let's have a Vermont law or nothing at all. I never thought that I would say this in public, but a Concealed Weapons Permit Act is gun control. SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator Tyson. Senator Chambers.
