SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Chambers, would you yield to a question from Senator Vrtiska, please?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator Chambers, you supported this bill when it was up here before and I think I understand why, because it had something to do with the drainage in north Omaha, which this bill would take away the Lincoln money. What about the Omaha money?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, I'm not the one who said everything is on the table.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. All right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: See, I'm very frank and direct, and I said I'm giving a representative sampling of the things that I think ought to go.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. Well, I understand that. But I suspect that if we took the money away from Lincoln we should probably consider taking away from Omaha, and the drainage problem that Senator Chambers addressed on this issue should be taken care of by the city of Omaha. I know there's been an attempt by him and others to get the job done and so far they haven't been able to get it done, and this was a way to get it done, but I don't think it was the right way. I don't think it was the right way because we're taking state tax dollars and putting in particular communities. And if you think that's a good idea you vote for it, but I don't think it's a good idea and so I'm going to support Senator Chambers' amendment. And I'm going to, Mr. Speaker, I'll give some time to Senator Janssen.
