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understand some things. And if it's one thing I understand, it's how difficult it is to make my colleagues see something that is as plain as the nose on their face. And you know why they can't see it? Because they don't know how to look cross-eyed. And unless you look cross-eyed, you can't see the nose on your face, unless you have a mirror.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I'm not talking about mirrors today. Mr. President, I will ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call please vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Johnson, Senator Don Pederson, Senator Hartnett, Senator Raikes, would you check in please? Thank you. Senator Bromm, Senator Preister, and Senator Connealy. The house is under call. Senators Johnson, Hartnett, Preister, Connealy, and Bromm. Senator Hartnett and Senator Preister. Here comes Senator Hartnett. Senator Preister. Senator Preister is on his way. Senator Chambers, how did you wish to proceed?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'll take a roll call vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question before the body is adoption of FA1330, which is an amendment to the first component of the divided committee amendments to LB 759. All in favor of the Chambers amendment, FA1330, vote aye, opposed nay. I'm sorry. I did not hear him say roll call vote. I'm sorry, Senator Chambers. I apologize. Sorry about that, Senator Chambers. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.
