Unexcused senators please report to the Chamber. Senator Janssen, Senator Johnson, will you check in, please? Thank you. Senator Jones, would you check in, please? Thank you. Senator Brown, Senator Landis, Senator Kruse, Senator Thompson, and Senator Connealy. Senator Kruse, the house is under call. And Senator Thompson. Senator Landis, will you check in, please? Thank you very much. Senator Kruse, the house is under call. Senator Connealy. All members present or accounted for, the question before the body is adoption of Chambers amendment FA1331, which is an amendment to the first component of the divided committee amendments to LB 759. All in favor of the motion vote aye, and opposed nay. We're voting on FA1331, which is an amendment to the divided committee amendments. Request for a record vote. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1354.)
17 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was not successful. I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk, next item to the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend this component of the committee amendment with FA1332. (Legislative Journal page 1354.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on FA1332.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm going to read the existing language that I want to strike, but I'm going to read it in the context of the entire passage. And this is on page 5. Lines 3 through 6 is what I will read. But the language I'm going to strike will be found in lines 3 and 4. This is subsection (i). "Ninth, beginning October 1, 2002, and continuing until October 1, 2004, the State Treasurer shall place the equivalent of twenty-eight cents of such tax in the Cash Reserve Fund." I would strike the following language. After "2002," beginning there, I would strike the following language: "and continuing until October 1, 2004." This is how the language would read if you agree with me
