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I'm not misstating what he said.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Wehrbein, did I misunderstand you?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I don't think so. I...under the present law, it's due to expire. I thought...Senator Brashear has a comment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President. Senator Chambers, we're moving it...it goes into the Cash Reserve Fund now.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: At the...at its expiration, which is the date you cite, October, of going into the Cash Reserve Fund, we're moving it to the General Fund.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you have other language that does that?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: And other language does that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And where is that language, so I know we're talking about the same money?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Can you give me a moment...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Sure.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: ...while your time is running?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Sure. And I will continue to discuss my general approach while Senator Brashear hunts that down. Oh, I would like to ask Senator Wehrbein to make a comment, if he will.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I said under present law it was due to expire, so you understood, Senator Chambers.
