We have this bill that has gone through the Revenue Committee process. We have a bill coming from Appropriations, or bills coming from Appropriations, that have gone through that process. Senator Chambers has already pointed out exactly what will be expected of us. We will be here in those final days, reconciling the revenue concept and the appropriations concept. And now Senator Quandahl has given us a new idea of how we could revisit this. He's also given notice to the world. (Laugh) If...the consequence of putting this on tonight is,...
