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some real controversy, some unclear regulations there. So I will support this amendment...adoption of the amendment, and then try and clean up some issues with livestock. And as I said, I'm really troubled with the snack food, and trying to get some uniformity in it. And I would propose to simply take a look at it on Select File and possibly just tax food. I think that solves the problem. With that, I would return the rest of my time to the Chair.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. (Visitors introduced.) On with discussion of AM1429, Senator Cunningham, followed by Senator Kremer and others.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. I'm getting heckled up here. I had some props to show you, but I found out that's not proper. So I'm going to line those up back in the senators lounge. And I would hope that you would all come back, and I'll go back and show you the difference, items that look the same, are very much the same; one is taxed, one is not taxed. Senator Brashear, would you respond?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Brashear, would you respond to a question?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Senator Brashear, this morning when you and I were talking, I was asking you about a Kit Kat candy bar and whether it should be taxed or not. You didn't know. And I tried to...you thought it should be. And I told you it wouldn't be because it flour in it. And then you went on...and I tried to make the point that as a grocer, that's the problem we have throughout the whole store. And your remark to me was...at our ending, was that simply you wouldn't have to read all those labels, because as a grocer you would just know that. And I can tell you, from the products I have lined up back here, I as a grocer...I've been in the grocery business for 29 years, owned my store for 22 years...I would not know that from looking at those items. And so I do have those items lined up. The pages are lining them up back there for me. I can really make a point to you if you will come back and look at them. And I plead with
