SENATOR KREMER: How much more money are we going to generate after we get...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR KREMER: ...through with the exemptions? Thank you very much. I'll...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kremer. Senator Schrock. Is Senator Schrock on the floor? I do not see him. We'll go on to...Senator Brashear, you're light is next. We'll pass over Senator Schrock.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President, members of the body, I would simply like...because we've had a noon recess and everything, I'd like to point out that this is technically a technical amendment that I want to be supportive of, that comes from the Revenue Committee, from its Chairman and its staff, that helps us work through a number of the difficult issues that relate to broadening this tax base, so that we are utilizing common terminology and definitions which are proven as being a part of the revenue regulatory process in other jurisdictions. And so notwithstanding the other issues we may address, I would urge the adoption of this amendment. And I am going to further attempt some clarifications that are necessary with regard to repair labor and the like, by the next amendment which will appear after the body has determined its will with regard to this one. Thank you.
