another state. They don't want to go there to gamble. They go there to buy their gasoline and they buy their groceries. They'll buy cigarettes if they're cheaper in another state than they are here. So we're losing more than just those gambling dollars that people feel as though that they can take away from themselves and use for those kinds of entertainment. But this is one way I believe that we can find a little extra added revenue and possibly help through our deficit a little bit. So with that, thank you, and I hope that you will support this amendment. If there are some technical amendments with it, we can address that between now and Select File. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Janssen. You've heard the closing. The question then before us is the adoption of AM1376 to FA1327, and a call of the house has been requested. All in favor of a call of the house please vote aye and opposed nay. Please record.
