SENATOR LANDIS: A machine vote is satisfactory. And in the event we need to, I will be asking for a roll call. But let's try the machine first.

SPEAKER BROMM: We started the machine vote, so you could authorize call-in votes, or we could take a different form of voting.

SENATOR LANDIS: Oh, in that case, I would authorize call-in votes, now that we're all sitting here. Thank you. Since we started a machine vote.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Landis. Call-in votes are authorized. Again, the question before us is the adoption of FA1327.

CLERK: Senator Aguilar voting yes. Senator Byars voting yes. Senator Kremer voting no. Senator Erdman voting no. Senator Engel voting yes. Senator Mines voting yes. Senator Cudaback voting yes. Senator Thompson voting yes. Senator Maxwell voting yes. Senator Tyson voting no. Senator McDonald voting no. Senator Hudkins voting no.

SPEAKER BROMM: Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the third component of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BROMM: This component is adopted. I raise the call. Next item on the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Brashear. Senator, AM1444. (Legislative Journal page 1393.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brashear, you're recognized to open on your amendment.
