where my land is going to be taxed, I think the levy is going to be \$1.06 with LB 540, not \$1.04, because of the levy exclusion. The operative date for the personal property tax exemption is January 1, '04. It does not affect this year's personal property. It will give you a chance to vote against the most punitive tax that young farmers pay. Thank you for your time.

SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: You've heard the closing on AM1479. Members, the question is the adoption of that amendment. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: (Microphone malfunction) ...and a roll call in reverse order.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schrock has requested a call of the house and a roll call in reverse order. All in favor of a call of the house please vote aye. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. Will all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. We are under call. Senator Mossey, Senator Friend, Senator Combs, Senator Dwite Pedersen, Senator Thompson, Senator Connealy. The request is to call the roll in reverse order. Mr. Clerk. And, again, for those who weren't here, the question is adoption of the Schrock amendment, AM1479.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1400-1401.) The vote is 17 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Schrock amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is not adopted. I raise the call. Next item on the bill, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, we're back to the Brashear amendment, AM1445.
