amendment, because I'm going to support Senator Chambers' amendment, for a different reason, though, and that's the lack of uniformity and the...just the ability to administer a tax on, what is it, gum and candy. I, as a practical matter, I don't see how in the world this thing is going to work. I'm one of these people, it's all or none, I guess. If we can't get all the food on the tax rolls, you know, sales tax, then I don't want any of it. This is such a hodgepodge the way we have it now. In fact, if...I'd like to get it off on prepared food, because it causes a problem the way it is, without adding another issue to it, trying to determine what has flour in it, and so on, et cetera, and juice content, you name it. I think it's simply a pie in the sky idea. Just, it's...practically it's not going to work. So Senator Chambers talks about Select File. Maybe we get this thing off of here, and we may end up needing \$100 million come time we get back to this bill on Select File. And then maybe sales tax on all food will work. I don't know. It's entered my mind. As I said yesterday, I'd like to see it either all or none. So...and I'm willing to try and get it on all food. So I'm going to support Senator Chambers' amendment on a whole different rationale, but I will be voting for it. With that, I return the rest of my time to the Chair. Thank you.

**SPEAKER BROMM:** Thank you, Senator Baker. Senator Chambers.

**SENATOR CHAMBERS:** Mr. President, members of the Legislature, some people think I'm bluffing. So the next amendment I'm going to put up there is to return this bill to committee. Then I have some other motions that I'm going to offer. I'm as serious as a heart attack. And we don't have that many days left in the session, so you all can challenge me right here if you want to, and put me in my place and show me that I cannot buffalo you. And I don't care. How can I lose? If you keep the discussion going on, how does that hurt me? The longer we discuss it here, the less time you have for the train wreck when you get to Select File, if you get there. But I want to discuss the process, because I know you all don't care about the people that I care about, so I'm not going to try to reach you on that right at this moment. How does the process work?
