SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. As stated earlier, the house is under call. Senator Schrock, would you check in, please. Senator Engel. Senator Combs. The house is under call. Senator Engel. And he's on his way. All present are accounted for. The question before the body is the Chambers amendment, AM1481 to LB 759. Senator Chambers, you requested a roll call vote in regular order? Right, Senator Chambers? Mr. Clerk, call the roll on the question.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1402.) The vote is 33 ayes, 7 nays on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk, next item.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend with AM1482.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on your amendment, AM1482, to LB 759.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, my amendment is not necessary. I'd withdraw it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Landis and Brashear would move to amend with AM1478. (Legislative Journal pages 1402-1404.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, you're recognized to open on your amendment, AM1478, to LB 759.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, yesterday Senator Brashear amended the construction area and you'll remember that I offered a series of amendments from the Revenue Department on the language in the bill.
