SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, for a motion. Senator Jones, for a motion.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. President, I make a motion that we adjourn until one-thirty.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion is to recess until one-thirty as Senator Jones said. All in favor of the motion say aye. Opposed nay. We are recessed.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good afternoon. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Senators, the afternoon session is about ready to reconvene. Please check in.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Do you have any announcements, Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Not at this time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Okay. I do have one here. (Visitors introduced.) We now go to General File, special order. Mr. Clerk, first bill.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, LB 540 was introduced by Senator Raikes. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time on January 21 of this year, referred to the Education Committee. That committee reports the bill to General File with committee amendments attached. (AM1287, Legislative Journal page 1264.)
