SENATOR RAIKES: I don't off the top of my head. I can tell you that statutorily the cap for the state reimbursement is 5 percent, so how ever much actual expenditures increase, the most the state support, the total state support, will increase is 5 percent.

SENATOR JONES: Okay. On another question is, under LB 806 that was passed, they was...you'd get 85 percent of what you got the year before if you didn't go under a certain mill levy. I think it was 90 mill levy. Now is there some provision in this for that?

SENATOR RAIKES: I think you're referring to the stabilization...

SENATOR JONES: Right.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...factor...

SENATOR JONES: Right.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...that's in the formula, and we did make an adjustment in that I think on this proposal and I'll get that information for you. I don't have it right on top my head.

SENATOR JONES: Well, the reason I brought that up, I had one school that was really going to be conservative so they went 98 or 89.9 and they got penalized.

SENATOR RAIKES: Oh, you're talking...I'm sorry, I had the wrong provision. I think you're talking about the minimum levy penalty,...

SENATOR JONES: Right.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...the minimal levy adjustment. We did adjust the minimum levy up to 94 cents.

SENATOR JONES: So they can go...but if they go under 94 are they going to get penalized again?
