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school to another school say the day before...say school starts on August 22nd, can I opt from one school to the other on opt...if both superintendents agree, on opt, August 21st?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuhr, would you respond?

SENATOR STUHR: Yes, it is my understanding now we will go back to the original provisions of the bill which set March 15th as that original date when they didn't need that agreement. And then after March 15th, they will have to be an agreement.

SENATOR HARTNETT: And that will go up...

SENATOR STUHR: Yes.

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...till school begins or even after school begins, Senator Stuhr, is that correct?

SENATOR STUHR: Well, I'm not sure. I don't believe...I think there are some provisions that once you have started school that you can't opt back out of that school. You can't attend school for a week or so and then decide that you're not going to make, you know, a certain team and then opt back again. So we'll go back to the original provisions.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay. Senator Raikes, did you hear my question?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, would you respond?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Can I opt, if I am an opt, can I opt from one school to another up to the last day before school begins if I get permission from the sending superintendent, or to the one school district A, to school B if they both...if they're okay?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes, you can, Senator.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay, that's...I think that was may concern. I thought as we were, you know, debating the bill before that we were going to stop this at the middle of July or someplace like that, and I think that, because I like the idea of putting the
