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example, the requiring minor...or personal and consumable items, a school would be allowed to request those but not require them. There is also a provision in there about course materials. Again, they could be requested but not required. This amendment is to clarify and, in a few cases, I think address or make some corrections to those provisions. First off, even though the personal consumer item...consumable items cannot be required for curricular activities, they may be required for extracurricular activities. That is a part of the amendment. It makes it clear in the amendment that schools can charge fees for parking. As I mention that, I'll remind you that the fee policy requires that money collected from students in the form of fees can only be put in a fund designated as such and used to provide the services or materials that the fee was collected for. So this can't be used as a general source of revenue for the school system. But fees, parking fees would be allowed. There was some concern that allowing schools to require reimbursement for lost or damaged property was not in the policy, so that we have explicitly included that as a part of this amendment. So again I think, I don't want to say it's totally technical. There are some substantive provisions here, but I think they are...I hope I've adequately explained them and I hope that you can agree to support them. I'd be happy to answer any questions. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. Open for discussion on the Raikes amendment, AM1380, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Raikes, with your amendment now and with the language that's in the bill, does the bill do anything that in one way or another changes the responsibility of the school district with respect to students who cannot afford to pay fees in any category, or is that policy the same even with all of the changes in the committee amendment and in your amendment right now?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes. I believe the one exception, Senator Beutler, would be not as provided in this particular amendment but in the bill, as amended by the committee amendment, would be providing spectator fees and...or spectator admissions and
