ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further pending to the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Open for discussion. Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 367 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Speaker Bromm, did you wish to speak?

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you. Just to remind members that at noon I will go to some Final Reading and so we will not be breaking for lunch, in case anyone was wondering about that. And as I announced, tried to, yesterday, should someone feel they need to get something to eat or whatever, please do that. ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, LB 626. I have no E & R amendments. I do have an amendment from Senator Preister. This is AM1421. (Legislative Journal page 1387.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Preister, you're recognized to open on AM1421 to LB 626.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the body, I appreciate the indulgence with moving this bill from General File to Select File to allow some time to work on the current amendment, AM1421, that's before us.
