Jensen from the Health and Human Services Committee, we had Senator Schimek who was involved through the Government Committee that heard the bill, Senator Beutler was involved through the Program Evaluation Committee, Senator Connealy had been involved through Business and Labor, and then later Senator Vrtiska through Business and Labor involved, and those members in the task force who attended the meeting signed off on this. Lauren Hill, who I just spoke with before coming in and who I had spoken with earlier in representing the administration has also agreed to this. And at this point, in the spirit of Senator Landis and his compromises, we have reached that point. And I think we have an amendment that will replace the original bill that gets a handle on having some assessment and a process for us being able to deal with the private service contracts that we let each year. If anyone is interested, I do have a copy of the HHS personal services contracts report that was done, and I do want to give credit to the Program Evaluation folks, as well as to Martha Carter and Andre Mick, who put it together. If anyone is interested in looking at that, I have a copy of that here. Other staff members, certainly Senator Schimek's staff did a good job. Christy Abraham, working on that through the Government Committee, put in a lot of time. The Business and Labor Committee, Laurie Lage, working with Senator Vrtiska, also has contributed. Kathy Tenopir with the Fiscal Office had been very involved and spent a lot of time working on it. Health and Human Services Jeff Santema was also very involved and certainly deserves credit there as well. And certainly, though last or almost last, Kate Allen in my office has spent probably four years or more working on the issue and has certainly contributed a great deal to the smooth operation and putting together this final version, and Kate has been working closely also with the administration, and Lauren Hill and Kate have worked well together. I certainly appreciate Kate's contribution. I also appreciate the administration being able to work on this, seeing it as a problem; Lauren Hill agreeing first in philosophy that we do need to have a better handle on these contracts and then sitting down over draft after redraft and working on it and putting this final version together. I think we get some assessment. I think we get some things that we haven't had in statute and, at the same time, we provide for some exemptions. It was looking like more than I
