I ask for your support of AM1421 and then the advancement of LB 626, and on Final Reading we will have a last amendment. And we will continue to work on the bill over the interim and see how the process works and working with the administration, who has been good to work with,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR PREISTER: ...and again I thank Lauren Hill. I thank everyone for their attention.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Preister. You've heard the closing on the Preister amendment, AM1421, which is to LB 626. The motion before the body is adoption of that amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the adoption of AM1421, offered by Senator Preister to LB 626. Have you all voted who wish to? Voting on adoption of AM1421 to LB 626. Have you all voted? Senator Preister, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR PREISTER: Mr. President, I would respectfully ask for a call of the house and I will accept call-in votes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 21 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. The issue before the body is AM1421, offered by Senator Preister, and he has authorized call-in votes. Senator Preister has authorized call-in votes on AM1421 to LB 626. We're going to let people check in before we start allowing call-in votes. We had a
