SENATOR SCHIMEK: Could I ask who you left out of this little caucus?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schimek, our internal operations are ours, and we don't share them with other people. But we know...we all know who that other person is, I think.

SPEAKER BROMM: There are no further lights. Senator Schimek, you're recognized to close on your amendment. She waives closing. The question then before us is the adoption of AM1084 to LB 358. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Schimek's amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: I have nothing further.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Mossey, you're recognized for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 358 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is to advance LB 358 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 332E. Mr. Clerk, do you have any messages, items for the record?
