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SENATOR TYSON: Do you want to pick a figure? There are 85. How many have in some term EPCs?

SENATOR JENSEN: Well, any hospital must take any patient that comes to their door. They are required by federal law to do that, and if they have a department, that's another story, but they will hold that individual in emergency care until they can be transferred.

SENATOR TYSON: For how long?

SENATOR JENSEN: Until they can be transferred.

SENATOR TYSON: Okay, my information is that there are places where you can take a patient, and they may have a requirement to do so, but the officer that has that man wants to get rid of him, and they won't sign for him. So he is stuck with him, and there is an officer off the street. But thank you, Senator Jensen. Senator Jensen says they have an inventory. I am sure they do have an inventory. He mentions the closing of the Nebraska Psychiatric Institute, which was...I think that it really falls into the category years ago. How many psychiatrists there are in the state of Nebraska? Perhaps he knows. I don't. How many advanced degree psychologists are in the state of Nebraska? Perhaps he knows. I don't. Maybe it's not necessary that I do, but it's necessary that the Legislature know. And all this calls for, if he already has this inventory, is to put it out where the Legislature can see it when we start. That's all that it does. But it does also ask for, how much money is involved? The level of education of the staffs, maybe he has all that. I don't know whether he does or not, but this calls for it. And here, again, this...all this is is a planning tool. I urge you to vote for the acquisition of the knowledge necessary to make good legislation whenever it comes by. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Tyson. You've heard the closing on AM1467 to LB 724. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on adoption of AM1467 offered by Senator Tyson to LB 724. Voting on AM1467. Have you all voted who care to?
