SENATOR RAIKES: Okay.

SENATOR VRTISKA: That's the point I was trying to get, so you're still using the same numbers, it's just how you apply them; either in General Fund where they are used for education or some of it transferred into education or the scholarship fund. So I guess my thought is the dollars are all the same, it's just how you apply them and what funds they are in. And I understand what you're saying except I don't understand, in a way, because we're still using \$8 million.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay, well, again, Senator, the best way I think I can hope to clarify it is that rather than some specific innovative or extra programs that are being supported by this lottery money, now it's all going to...

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...sort of the basic general support.

SENATOR VRTISKA: But you're going to transfer that \$4 million back into where the \$8 million was, as I understand it.

SENATOR RAIKES: We would take...we would use \$4 million of the \$8 million that is currently going to the General Fund or, more exactly, \$4 million of the \$8 million that would go to the General Fund in the 2004-2005 fiscal year, we would use \$4 million of that \$8 million to support need-based aid programs in that 2004-2005 fiscal year and...

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...actually from then on.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Senator Stuhr.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I rise in support of the committee amendment because I do
