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new facility, and then to appropriate the money to get the matching federal money. So, yes, we did appropriate \$100,000, I believe it was, last year.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: All right.

SENATOR PREISTER: We did complete the study and we have all that information.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I appreciate hearing that and I just thought that the rest of the body needed to maybe hear a few of those particulars as well. So thank you for your explanation.

SENATOR PREISTER: You're welcome.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Schimek. The Chair would recognize Senator Preister.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Mr. President. I would just, if Senator Wehrbein would answer a couple of questions, like to clarify. Senator Wehrbein,...

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR PREISTER: ...in the budget, and I'm going back to page 72,...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR PREISTER: ...where you were, you've got \$5.7 million that's being appropriated as the state match. That accurate?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR PREISTER: And it also lists in there 150-bed facility.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.
