SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: You've heard the closing on the committee amendments. The question is then the adoption of the committee amendments. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. We're voting on the committee amendments. Please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER BROMM: The committee amendments are adopted. Mr. Clerk, do you have some items that you'd like to read?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President, thank you. I have an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Burling (re LB 755); new resolution, LR 81, offered by Senator Thompson, a study resolution that will be referred to the Executive Board; confirmation report...a confirmation hearing report from Transportation and Telecommunications; and a series of amendments to LB 479 by Senator Bourne. SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next amendment to the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maxwell would move to amend with AM1601. (Legislative Journal page 1507.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Maxwell, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR MAXWELL: Thank you, Mr. President. This amendment would eliminate funding for state aid in the second year of this budget. Earlier this session, Nebraskans for Peace had a mock press conference in the Rotunda. The featured guest wore a
