SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President and members. I wasn't really going to turn my light on again, but I had a call to my office a few minutes ago and I really meant to ask someone this the last time I was at the mike. Do we have an office for refugees? And the call to my office indicated that we do and I thought I needed to mention that. It's housed in Health and Human Services. And I was thinking that we did. In fact, I know the woman who heads that office, known her for a long time, and I was remiss in not mentioning that when I made my remarks. And then, Senator Jensen, I also wanted to mention to you that the Mexican-American Commission does pretty much serve all Latinos and, in fact, they just had this horrendous big discussion in their commission about renaming the Mexican-American Commission and they finally decided not to because historically that's what it's been named. I suspect that one of these days they will rename it. But they do serve a much larger population than just the Mexican community, so I wanted to get that on the record too. Thank you, Mr. President.
