to be proceeding. And it all hinges on this to happen. And I think that is all the detail. There is a discussion of this also on page 71 and 72 in your goldenrod book, much of which I just said. That is the purpose of LB 403 now, once the committee amendment is adopted into LB 403.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Are there any persons wishing to address LB 403? We do have committee amendments, I understand. So Senator Wehrbein, I know you've been speaking of them; would you like to open on committee amendments?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, I have. What I just described is the committee amendment. That will become the bill. Once again, if you did not catch it, the title now is different. The purpose of the bill is different from the title. And so the committee amendment will become the bill to do this. You might ask, what would happen from the Environmental Trust Fund? That happened in...that will have happened in the mainline bill, LB 407. So this is a vehicle to carry this new purpose of the bill, which is the amendment that I just talked about in detail. Once again, there's more discussion of that. Much of what I read is in the committee statement that is with the amendment, and also on page 71 and 72 of the goldenrod book.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. You've heard the opening on the committee amendments. Is there any discussion? Seeing none, Senator Wehrbein, you could close on committee amendments if you wish.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes. Well, a question was just asked about, it save us money? This does buy us a new administration center, a cooperative effort between the National Guard and the State Patrol and our Emergency Management. It is primarily...most of that is paid for with federal funds. Our share of that is \$975,000 of General Fund. But once we sell the state property, we should net \$2.5 million for our General Fund, as these events unfold. And that, Mr. Speaker, is the crux of this amendment.
