SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. Senator Cunningham.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. Could I ask Senator Wehrbein a question?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein, would you respond to a question?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Senator Wehrbein, in the litter reduction fee that we're going to rob, is the part that comes from business, is there enough money in that fund to keep from having to raise the rates then next year?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We didn't discuss that. But I think we were comfortable that we didn't necessarily have to raise rates. There is enough cash in there at this point that we felt we could use this as a bridge through these tough times.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Well, you know, last year we did the same thing with the Weights and Measures.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It will not raise rates.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: We're sure of that?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's the intent.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Because with the Weights and Measures, we did that last year, I think, during the special session. Then we had to come through and just about triple the rates. We did that...we've already done that now this year. So I would hope that we're not robbing funds that are being paid in for a certain cause, and then you're going to triple or double the rates again next time.
