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always that risk. But that's not our intent.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I can never say never.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jones on AM1388.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. President, members of the body, I'd like to ask Senator Baker a question if I could.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: Yes.

SENATOR JONES: Yes. A year ago, on LB 1085, we passed that half a cent sales tax so it could go in the Highway Trust Fund. But it actually went in the Cash Reserve and not went to the Highway Trust. Okay. What keeps it from going into the Cash Reserve until the year is up? I mean, ...you know, that don't end until October 1.

SENATOR BAKER: That part of it still goes into Cash Reserve. This new provision would go into the General Fund. Is that what you're asking?

SENATOR JONES: Yeah. Well, in other words, it will stop going in the Cash Reserve as quick as this bill is passed? Or when will it stop going in there?

SENATOR BAKER: No, I think that provision...and maybe Senator Wehrbein would clarify, but I believe that still goes into the Cash Reserve until October 1 of 2003.

SENATOR JONES: That's what I wondered.

SENATOR BAKER: That's my understanding.

SENATOR JONES: And then from there on it would go into the
