using today. But we feel that we're being very modest here. It does help us bridge over. Some of these funds are going to be used for...beyond all of our, nearly, lifetimes, in terms of cleanup. So there may be some impact down the road. But we're trying to utilize those funds that we have available to the maximum. And that's what this transfer is about. And it's these several transfers here. We think they're responsible. And I will be sending...there will be a few more later on in other bills that I'll explain fuller. But that's the extent of this amendment, Mr. Speaker.
