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SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I'd like to ask Senator Wehrbein a question.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Wehrbein, would you yield to a question from Senator Vrtiska?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: I didn't catch all that you said. You said this is changing from "shall" to "may?"

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: And this position is now...is not filled?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: And what was the rest of it you said?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We said that if they want it to be filled with sources other than General Fund it could be. Rather than abolish the position, we simply said it may be filled; that therefore if there's private funds, foundation funds, whatever, that this could be continued. We're not wiping the position out, but simply says it may be filled and not shall.

SENATOR VRTISKA: But the funding will not be there?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We do not have any General Funds in it, no.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay, that's...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes. I mean, yes, we do not.

SENATOR VRTISKA: ...that's the part I didn't catch. Thank you very much. That's...return the rest of my time back to the Chair.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Senator Stuthman.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body.
