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something like that. But if that's not the amount, you can run through it real quickly and total it up in your head. Unless you're one of those who's become tied to a calculator. But that is the amendment. And if you have any questions on this amendment, you can ask Senator Vrtiska. No, I will answer any questions on this amendment. I wanted to see if he was paying attention, and he did, because his papers went flying in every direction. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Synowiecki.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Senator Chambers, I just notice from your amendment to the green copy, ...if you would yield, please, Senator Chambers?

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Chambers, would you yield, please?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes I will.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: The green copy, Senator Chambers, is littered with claims from the Lincoln County attorney. And then your amendment, in my real quick, brief review, contains no billing from the Lincoln County attorney. Can you...do you know the...can you educate me on the background of these claims by the Lincoln County attorney, and why they do not appear on the...on your amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The documentation requested was not given. And a representative of the County Attorneys Association worked with the committee staff on this. And we were not, and are not, ...at least I will oppose paying any claim where documentation substantiating the validity of the claim is not given to the committee. Every other county attorney did it.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Thank you, Senator. Another thing interesting to me is that Douglas County, the county that both you and I rep...our districts reside in, is not a part of either the green copy or the amended version. It's my understanding that the AG's Office has been handling these appeals for the Douglas County section of this. Is that your understanding as
