SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. You've heard the opening on AM1556 to LB 305. Open for discussion on that motion. Senator Byars.

SENATOR BYARS: Thanks, Senator Cudaback. I want to commend Senator Erdman for bringing this amendment and bringing the legislation that he introduced. I would be strongly, strongly in support of what he's doing. Any time we can improve education, truly improve education, any time we can work towards savings lives and preventing injury I feel is all part of the public health process. And I wanted to commend him again and I will support the amendment. Because we do have a little hog issue in the entire bill, LB 305, I will probably be the only red voting against it, but I am very strongly in support of AM1556.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Byars. Any further discussion on AM1556? Seeing no lights on, Senator Erdman, did you wish to close?

SENATOR ERDMAN: Briefly, Mr. President. Thank you. I'd also like to thank Senator Byars, Senator Jensen, Senator Foley, for their cosponsorship of LB 348, which is the underlying idea behind AM1556, and would appreciate your support on this amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. You've heard the closing on AM1556. The question before the body is, shall AM1556 be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay.
