Senator Brashear, will you check in, please? The house is under call. All present...all present or accounted for. Senator Mines, how did you wish to proceed?

SENATOR MINES: Machine vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You had a machine vote already. You already had a machine vote, Senator Mines. Are you authorizing call-in votes?

SENATOR MINES: Yes, sir.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Roll call vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Been a request for a roll call vote. There has been a request for a roll call vote, regular order. The question before the body is we're ceasing debate. Senator Thompson. The primary introducer can request what roll call he wants it in, reverse or primary. He did not state it, so you're requesting a reverse order. Mr. Clerk, call the roll in reverse order.

CLERK: Senator, just to be sure, you might want to restate that we are voting to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: And we are voting on ceasing debate on AM1661 to AM1414 to LB 440. Mr. Clerk, call the roll in reverse order on that motion.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1581.)
16 ayes, 27 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to cease debate was not successful. I do raise the call. We'll go back to discussion of AM1661 to committee amendments, AM1414, to LB 440. Senator
